UNIFORM POLICY

This uniform policy has been created (in conjunction with staff) and approved by the School Governing Council.

Whilst attending Angaston Primary School students are expected to wear the school uniform at all times unless otherwise stated by staff. Whilst students are wearing the school uniform they do represent the school even when not on school grounds.

Items of clothing can be purchased from the schools uniform shop or ordered through the school office. Second hand uniforms are often available, enquire at the uniform shop.

If you are unable to obtain a uniform; plain navy blue clothing is an acceptable alternative. The Angaston Primary School uniform has been designed with sun safety in mind and children are expected to wear sun smart clothing at all times including casual clothing days (e.g. shoulders covered, no singlet tops). Children are also encouraged to apply sunscreen especially on high UV days.

The Angaston Primary School uniform options are as follows:

Summer

Hat 1 & 4	Navy blue, Full brim with or without monogram, compulsory terms
Dress	Blue check, zip pocket
Shorts/culottes/skorts	Navy blue
Shirt	Polo navy blue with white flashing, plain navy blue polo, with or without monogram
Socks	Navy blue, black or white
Windcheater	Navy blue with or without monogram or navy cardigan or jumper NO HOODS

Winter

Track pants	Navy blue
Pants/trousers	Navy blue only - NO JEANS
Tights / leggings	Navy blue
Skirt	Navy blue
Culottes	Navy blue
Shirt	Polo navy blue, with or without monogram (plain white or navy blue long sleeved shirt or skivvy may be worn underneath polo)

Socks	Navy blue, black or white
Windcheater	Navy blue with or without monogram or navy cardigan or jumper NO HOODS Year 7 commemorative jumper, issued yearly
Beanie	Plain navy blue only. No logos. Only to be worn outside.
Scarf	Navy blue or white (no logos or other colours)
Jacket/vest	Navy blue only. No logos. Only to be worn outside.
Shoes	Must be supportive of student's feet and allow them to run and safely participate in PE activities freely. Footwear must cover the toes for protection; this is a Work, Health and Safety requirement by the school.

Children may wish to bring suitable footwear and/or clothing in which to change for sports lessons, rather than wearing sneakers all day long.

JEWELLERY/MAKE-UP/HAIR ACCESSORIES

Children may wear plain studs or sleeper earrings. Dangling earrings are not accepted due to health and safety risks.

Children are not permitted to wear bracelets, necklaces or wrist bands, with the exception of medic-alert items.

Nail polish and make-up is not permitted. If children are found to be wearing nail polish or make-up they will be required to have it removed as soon as practical.

Any hair accessories must be plain navy blue or white.
