



Uniform Policy

This uniform policy has been created in conjunction with staff and the school Governing Council.

Whilst attending Angaston Primary School students are expected to wear the school uniform at all times unless otherwise stated by staff. Whilst students are wearing the school uniform they do represent the school even when not on school grounds.

Items of clothing can be purchased from the school's uniform shop or ordered through the school office. Second hand uniforms are often available.

If you are unable to obtain a uniform; plain navy blue clothing is an acceptable alternative.

The Angaston Primary School uniform has been designed with sun safety in mind and children are expected to wear sun smart clothing at all times including casual clothing days e.g. shoulders covered, no singlet tops. Children are also encouraged to apply sunscreen especially on high UV days.

The Angaston Primary School uniform options are as follows:

Summer

Hat	Navy blue, Full brim with or without monogram, and NO CORDS . Worn all year round.
Dress	Blue check, zip pocket
Shorts/skirts/leggings	Navy blue
Polo Shirt - Short sleeve	Navy blue with white flashing, plain navy blue polo, with or without monogram
Windcheater	Navy blue with or without monogram or navy cardigan or jumper (no hoods) Year 6 commemorative jumper
Socks	Navy blue, black or white
Shoes	Must be supportive of student's feet and allow them to run and safely participate in PE activities. Footwear must cover the toes for protection (Health and Safety requirement).

Winter

Track pants/trousers	Navy blue (no Jeans)
Tights / leggings	Navy blue
Skirts	Navy blue

Polo Shirt - Long Sleeve	Navy blue, with or without monogram (plain white or navy blue long sleeved shirt or skivvy may be worn underneath polo)
Windcheater	Navy blue with or without monogram or navy cardigan or jumper (no hoods) Year 6 commemorative jumper
Socks	Navy blue, black or white
Shoes	Must be supportive of student's feet and allow them to run and safely participate in PE activities. Footwear must cover the toes for protection (Health and Safety requirement).
Jacket/vest	Navy blue preferred. Not a substitute for uniform jumper. Only to be worn outside.
Beanie/Scarf	Navy blue preferred. Only to be worn outside.

JEWELLERY/MAKE-UP/HAIR ACCESSORIES

Children may wear plain studs or sleeper earrings. Dangling earrings are not accepted due to health and safety risks.

Children are not permitted to wear bracelets, necklaces or wrist bands, with the exception of medic-alert and sensory items as approved by class teacher.

Nail polish and make-up is not permitted. If children are found to be wearing nail polish or make-up they will be required to remove it as soon as practical.

Any hair accessories must be navy blue or white.
